

Web Mapping Help

This mapping system is provided by the City of Beaumont as a resource to all Citizens & Employees. The data herein has been verified as thoroughly as possible, but the City makes no guarantee for the accuracy or completeness of the maps.

Navigation Tools



North Navigator-Click on N-S-E-W to pan the map in that direction.



Zoom Level-Click (+) to zoom in and (-) to zoom out.

Map Tools



Zoom In-Use this tool to zoom into the map. Click on the map to center & zoom into a point, or click & drag a box to zoom to a specific location of your choosing.



Zoom Out-Much the same as the Zoom In tool, this tool will zoom you to a larger view of the city. Click on the map to center & zoom out at a point, or click & drag a box to zoom out further or smaller (the smaller the box the further you will be zoomed out)



Pan-Used to move the map, similar to sliding a piece of paper. Click & drag to shift the map display.



Zoom Full Extent-Zooms to the entire City.



Back Extent/Forward Extent-Go back/forward to the last extent viewed.



Magnifier-Use this tool to use a magnifier window. Drag the window over the map to view a zoomed version of the area. Magnification can be set by clicking the drop down box within the window and selecting a zoom factor.



Identify-This tool is used to identify information about features on the map, this works on all layers. The resulting identify table can be added to results or printed by printing the map. Also you can cut and paste the table into another document if so desired (Ctrl+C, Ctrl+V).



Measure-Use this tool to measure distances on the map. Point XY Coordinates, Line length, and Polygons can be measured. When measuring polygons, and 3 or more points are clicked, the perimeter and area of the box will be calculated. This will update each time a new point is selected.



Overview Map-Use this tool to see where you are on the map.

Data Tools

Find Address-Find address by typing in House Number and Street Name.

Search Data-Search Property Lines by Owner Name, or JCAD Account. Also search Planning and Zoning Cases by case number.

Results-Contains search results from using the Search Data tools. Right clicking an entry will present a context menu, enabling Zoom, Pan, and Remove.

Layers

Map Contents-Displays the Layers that are available in the current map. Layers can be turned on or off. This also serves as a type of map legend in that it displays the symbols that are used on the map.

 Click the plus sign to expand a group.

 Click the minus sign to reduce a group.

A hidden layer, click to “check” and make visible.

A visible layer, click to “uncheck” and hide.

A visible layer, but not at this scale. Zoom “in” or “out” to view.
